Monday 17th July Bl John Sugar & Robert Grissold

John Sugar and Robert Grissold were both martyred at Warwick in 1604. Sugar, a seminary priest who ministered in the Midlands was arrested with Grissold, a layman who refused the chance to escape and leave Sugar.

Thursday 20th July St. Apollinaris

Apollinaris died in the first century. According to tradition he was a native of Antioch who became bishop of Ravenna. He met a martyrs death and is patron of all who suffer epilepsy and gout.

Friday 21st July St Lawrence of Brindisi

Lawrence was born in 1559 and became a member of the Capuchin Order. He travelled throughout Europe preaching the faith and was a Doctor of the Church. He died in Portugal in the year 1619.

Saturday 22nd July St. Mary Magdalene

Mary Magdalen died 1st Century. She was healed of possession and became a follower of Jesus and was present at the crucifixion. In Mark's gospel she is the first witness of the risen Lord.
