- ❖ **NEXT SUNDAY**, October 31st, we celebrate the transferred Solemnity of All Saints.
- ❖ **HOLY BAPTISM:** Congratulations to Henry Robert George Schofield, who was baptised in our church last Saturday. We pray for him and for his family.
- ❖ **PREPARING FOR THE SYNOD:** At a meeting of the Stafford Deanery on Tuesday, Bishop Stephen Wright, our Area Bishop, spoke to the Fathers about the forthcoming Synod, as highlighted in the Archbishop's Letter of last weekend. The preparatory timetable laid down by the Vatican is extremely tight – our Diocesan contribution has to be submitted by the end of February. The Archbishop wrote a lot about "listening" and Bishop Stephen suggested that we (priests) ask you (laity) to write down your thoughts, hopes, desires about the Church, as we now are, and as we might want to be. The Bishop also thought it would be good for those whose attachment to the Church is more tenuous to also be involved, so you could issue this invitation more widely. So: if any of you feel inclined to write over the next couple of weeks, please let me have what you come up with. No individual names will be disclosed!
