FEAST DAYS Monday 4th October St. Francis of Assisi

(1182 - 1226) St Francis was born at Assisi. He renounced his privileged family life and bound himself to God by embracing a simple lifestyle. With Saint Clare he laid the foundations for the establishment of the Franciscan Order: He famously said, 'Preach the gospel at all times, and if necessary use words'

Tuesday 5th October St Luigi Scrosoppi of the Oratory

(1804 – 1884) He was an Italian priest who founded the Sisters of Providence of Saint Cajetan of Thiene. He joined the Oratory of Saint Philip Neri in 1846 and was elected as its provost in 1856. He was canonized in 2001

Wednesday 6th October St. Bruno

(1035 - 1101) He was born in Cologne and, following his studies in Paris and priestly ordination, he wanted to live a life of solitude and founded the monastery of La Grande Chartreuse and the Carthusian Order of absolute contemplative life. Pope Urban II called upon his wise advice and counsel.

Saturday 9th October Saint John Henry Newman

Born in London in 1801. As an Anglican he was influential in the Oxford movement. He was received into full communion with the Church by Blessed Dominic of the Mother of God on this day in 1845 while living at Littlemore, Oxford. Following his ordination to the priesthood he founded the Oratory of Saint Philip Neri in England. Through his writings, sermons and pastoral care he brought Christian instruction and encouragement to many people. He died in Birmingham on 11 August 1890. He was Beatified by Pope Benedict XVI in Birmingham on 19 September 2010 and Canonised by Pope Francis on 13 October 2010.
