Tuesday 5th April St. Vincent Ferrer

(1350 - 1419) St Vincent was born in Valencia, Spain. He was renowned as a preacher, a missionary, and a teacher of theology. He converted thousands of sinners, Jews and Moors by his preaching. He died in 1419 while preaching in Brittany and was buried at Vannes.

Thursday 7th April St John Baptiste de la Salle

(1651 - 1719) St John was born in Rheims, France. He was known as the Father of Modern Pedagogy. He opened free schools for the poor children, introducing new teaching methods. He organised the congregation called the Brothers of Christian Schools, which made great contributions to popular education.
