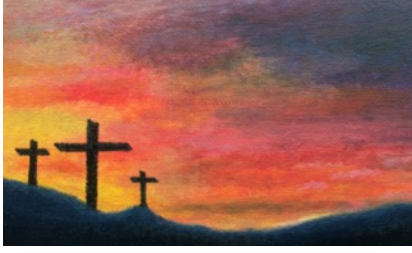

- ❖ **PALM SUNDAY:** Saturday evening's Mass begins with the Simple Blessing of the palms. On Sunday morning (weather permitting) palms will be blessed outside church, followed by the customary procession.
- ❖ **MAUNDY THURSDAY:** At the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper (7pm), our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion should strive to be present so as to renew their commitment for another year.
- ❖ **GOOD FRIDAY:** There will be the usual collection for the support of the Holy Places. Please remember that Good Friday is a Day of Fasting and Abstinence – those between 18 and 60 should have just one full meal; those over 14 abstain from meat.
- ❖ **HOLY SATURDAY:** The Easter Vigil begins at 8pm. There are no other Masses on Saturday.
- ❖ **EASTER CLERGY OFFERING:** The collection next weekend is the annual Easter Offering for your Parish Priest. Special envelopes are available in church for this. Please do not use the normal Gift Aid envelopes.
- ❖ **OF YOUR CHARITY** please pray for all who are sick at this time, both at home and in hospital; for those who have died recently, and for those whose anniversaries occur about now: Basil Thomas Fitzherbert, Josephine Bancroft, Mary Barrincou & William Jamieson.
