- ❖ **NEXT SUNDAY IS CORPUS CHRISTI**, the great feast in honour of Our Lord present in the Blessed Sacrament, the Most Holy Eucharist. We will have a short Procession of the Blessed Sacrament at the end of Mass on Sunday morning, ending with Benediction. If the weather is fine we will go outdoors, around the War Memorial; if wet we will process around the Church.
- ❖ **SECOND COLLECTION:** Next weekend we have the annual Second Collection for the "Day for Life", which supports the various pro-life groups at work in the Diocese and beyond.
- ❖ **THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE PROPAGATION OF THE FAITH (APF):** Every six or seven years a representative of the APF visits parishes to make an appeal for new members, and to get people to have one of their famous 'Red Boxes' as an easy way to raise money for the missions. Our turn for such an appeal has come round, so we will be welcoming a speaker on the weekend of July 2nd/3rd. This not an appeal for money, but for your long-term support.
- ❖ **WEEKDAY MASS TIMES:** The recent poll on preferred times for weekday Mass has yielded a small majority in favour of 10am. So, with effect from Monday July 4th weekday Masses will usually be at 10am - exceptions of course for hospital visits etc.
